## PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE EXTERMINATION OF FLEAS

- 1. Tenants must vacate the home / apartment for a minimum of six (6) hours; anyone suffering from asthma or respiratory problems eight (8) hours; anyone with a heart condition, who is pregnant or young infants twenty-four (24) hours.
- 2. Pets must be out of the home for six (6) hours. It is the responsibility of the home owner to treat the animal for fleas.
- 3. Give as much free floor space as possible, including closet floors. If you wish the furniture and mattresses to be sprayed, please let us know. All bedding should be laundered.
- 4. A thorough vacuuming of all floor areas, including the basement, must be done before the extermination. Be sure to throw the vacuum bag away. After the first vacuuming following the spraying, throw that vacuum bag away as well.
- 5. You may continue to see fleas for 21 days. The chemical kills the adult fleas, but not the eggs. The eggs keep hatching and those fleas get into the chemical and die. This process takes at least 21 days.
- 6. Failure to comply with these instructions may result in a delay of work being done by our company.
